3. Read Galatians 1:6-7. Paul marveled that some of the people in the region of Galatia were turning from their calling in the grace of Christ and going after some "other gospel". Do you marvel, or ever wonder why a person would turn from the good news of Christ, and go after some strange false gospel? What would you tell such a person?
4. Read Galatians 1:8-10. What are some of the "benefits and pitfalls" of being a "man pleaser"? What are some of the "benefits and pitfalls" of living to "please God"? Do you prefer to live for "man" or "God"? Why?
