Galatians 2

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this week's Bible study did you find to be most helpful, eye-opening, or perhaps troubling? Explain.
2. Read Galatians 2:1-3. Do you ever feel compelled to go back to the old things that you were in bondage to before you were saved? What helps you to not give into the temptation to go back to the old ways?
3. Read Galatians 2:4-6. We all remember having a classmate who was "the teachers pet". They were seemingly the teachers' favorite student in the class. Well God doesn't have favorites. Paul tells us in verse 6 that "God shows personal favoritism to no man". How does this fact affect you? What happens when people show favoritism to one person over another?
4. Read Galatians 2:11-13. Peer pressure.... It's real. In these verses Peter felt it and gave into it. What should have Peter done when his Jewish buddies showed up in Antioch and found him fellowshiping and eating with the Gentile believers? Have you ever given into the wrong side of peer pressure? What would you do differently today?
